
What keeps children from walking or biking to school?



























What would help children walk or bike to school?

A group of students who walk to school together with adult supervision

A group of students who bike to school together with adult supervision

Students get dropped off at a location within walking distance to school, then walk together to school

Mileage Club

Incentivize walking and biking to school by tracking miles and providing gifts or prizes when a mileage goal is reached

Walk! Bike! Fun! Curriculum at School

Curriculum teaches children traffic rules and regulations and handling skills needed to bike and walk effectively and safely

Safer Intersections/ Crossings

Improved intersection crossing designs, markings, and signs around schools

Improved sidewalks and paths connecting to schools
